940 CMR 29.00: Open Meetings

Emergency means a sudden, generally unexpected occurrence or set of circumstances demanding immediate action.

(1) Requirements Applicable to All Public Bodies. (a) Except in an emergency, public bodies shall file meeting notices sufficiently in advance of a public meeting to permit posting of the notice at least 48 hours in advance of the public meeting, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, in accordance with M.G.L. c. 30A, § 20. In an emergency, the notice shall be posted as soon as reasonably possible prior to such meeting.
