## Billerica Historical Commission Eligibility Form

The Billerica Historical Commission is requesting funding to operationalize Phase One of the Historical Resource Inventory plan produced by Wendy Frontiero. (For the Final Plan, see <a href="https://www.town.billerica.ma.us/DocumentCenter/View/12205/Billerica-survey-plan-final-report-09-02-2024-?bidId=">https://www.town.billerica.ma.us/DocumentCenter/View/12205/Billerica-survey-plan-final-report-09-02-2024-?bidId=</a>) Phase One includes 12 properties on Boston Road, the town cemeteries, 15 churches and private civic buildings, the Mount Pleasant Street and Garden City area, Richardson Mill area, and the old Middlesex Turnpike bridge abutments for a total of 185 properties.

The Committee agreed this project is eligible for CPC funding. They discussed how long each phase will take, how much each additional phase would cost, and who would be managing the funding. Ingram answered that each phase is expected to take a year and a half, additional phases will cost approximately \$33,000, and the funding will be managed through the Planning Department.
