History

The **Shawsheen River** is a 26.7-mile-long tributary of the Merrimack River in northeast Massachusetts. It rises gently from a Bedford meadow and eventually finds its way to the Atlantic. Its name comes from the Indian words for "Great Spring" and "Beauty's Pathway."

Shaloo Meadow Forest and Shawsheen Woods are 30 acres of conservation lands managed for the preservation of flood plains, wetlands and wildlife habitat. The Shawsheen River meanders through these conservations lands and is accessible throughout the area. These sites are public lands that allow for passive recreation, including canoeing, fishing and nature study.
