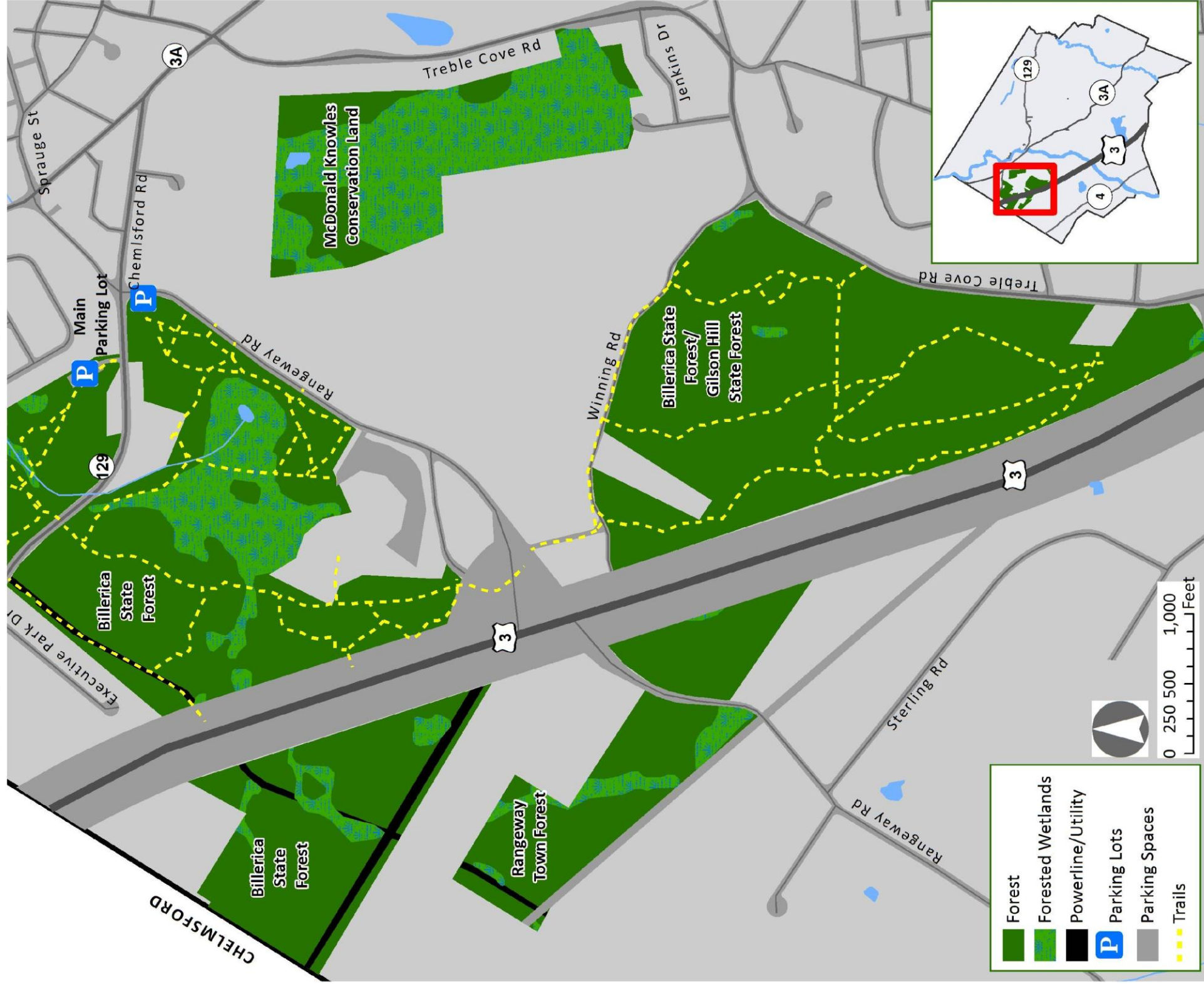

Directions

Head north on Boston Rd (3A). Take a left onto Chelmsford Road and the 2nd left onto Rangeway Road to access the State and Town Forests.

Head north on Boston Rd (Route 3A). Take a left onto Treble Cove Road to access McDonald Knowles Conservation Land. Access is also available from Meadowglen Road off of Treble Cove Road.

There are no designated parking lots for Billerica State Forest/Gilson Hill State Forest, Rangeway Forest or McDonald Knowles Land. These lands are most easily accessible via bike or walking.

Land Information

Billerica State Forest is a state owned forest managed by Massachusetts DCR. It is available for public use and offers many opportunities for nature study and hiking trails.

Rangeway Town Forest is a town owned forest managed by Billerica's Conservation Commission. It is available for public use and consists of mostly pine forests. The Old Middlesex Turnpike is now a dirt road and runs through the property.

McDonald Knowles Conservation Land is a town owned property managed by the Conservation Commission. It is available for public use and consists of forested wetlands that are protected for wildlife. Wetland, grassland, and forested areas provide habitat for a wide variety of wildlife and provides visitors with excellent opportunities for bird watching and nature study.
