

BILLERICA BOARD OF HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS

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The following rules and regulations were adopted by the Billerica Board of Health at its meeting of March 24, 2003. The latest revisions were adopted June 9, 2014.

PURPOSE:

The Billerica Board of Health is responsible for the protection of the public health, welfare, and environment in the Town of Billerica. In an effort to protect the public, the following rules and regulations are promulgated to supplement those of the Massachusetts General Laws.

AUTHORITY/APPLICABILITY:

These regulations are adopted pursuant to the authority of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 111, Section 31 and Section 127 as well as Title 1, 310 CMR 11.02 and Title 5, 310 CMR 15.003 of the Massachusetts State Environmental Code and the Stormwater Management By-law (Articles XXV, General By-laws of the Town of Billerica).
