Approval of Meeting Minutes

John Gagliardi presented the minutes from the meeting held on April 29, 2024, for approval.

Larry Norman made a motion to accept the meeting minutes as presented and was seconded by Dina Favreau. The committee voted unanimously to approve.

Article 4, Spring Special Town Meeting Warrant

Petitioner Presentation

Daniel Darris O'Connor explained that the petitioners submitted the article because they believed that the Town Meeting body may not be reflective of the will of the residents. The State of Massachusetts has specific requirements for a referendum, but the Town of Billerica goes further.

He explained that the article requires a super majority, 2/3 vote, to pass the Town Meeting. It then must be approved by the Attorney General, and then go to residents for a final vote.

Response and Discussion

Committee members engaged in discussion with petition presenter and topics included the challenges of obtaining a 2/3 threshold vote, the 'small D' democratic process, and the legality of the article with the State because Town Council had not submitted an opinion.

Larry Norman made a motion to vote for the article as written and was seconded by Dina Favreau.

Committee voted to recommend Article 4 to Town Meeting 6-3 with one abstaining vote.

Adjournment

Larry Norman made a motion to adjourn the meeting as was seconded by Dina Favreau.

The meeting adjourned at 6:39 PM.
