Board of Appeals

Reviews requests for zoning relief, such as variances and special permits.

Why it matters: Helps property owners move forward while balancing neighborhood impacts.

Board of Health

Enforces health codes, conducts inspections, and addresses public health concerns.

Why it matters: Keeps restaurants safe and protects public health.

Beautification Committee

Improves public spaces through landscaping and enhancement projects.

Why it matters: Helps make Billerica more welcoming and attractive.

Billerica Substance Awareness & Prevention (BSAP)

Provides education and prevention around substance use.

Why it matters: Supports a safer, healthier community.

Billerica Community Alliance

Connects local groups and residents to support community initiatives.

Why it matters: Strengthens collaboration across the community.

Billerica Resident Employment Monitoring Committee

Tracks local hiring commitments on development projects.

Why it matters: Helps ensure residents benefit from development.

Bylaw Review Committee

Reviews and recommends updates to Town bylaws.

Why it matters: Keeps local laws current and effective.

Cable Advisory Committee

Advises on cable services and supports BATV.

Capital Needs Assessment Committee

Plans for long-term infrastructure and facility needs.

Cemetery Commission

Oversees Town cemeteries and burial operations.

Commission on Disability

Advocates for accessibility and inclusion.

Why it matters: Ensures equal access for all residents.

Community Preservation Committee (CPC)

Recommends CPA funding for projects.

Why it matters: Supports housing, recreation, open space, and historic preservation.

Conservation Commission

Protects wetlands and natural resources.

Why it matters: Safeguards the environment and reduces flooding risks.

Housing Authority

Manages public housing and assistance programs.

Supports affordable housing initiatives.

Library Board of Trustees
